



OUR QUALITY CHARTER

Since the beginning of the 20th century, GL Bijoux has maintained a quality label that has constantly improved.

At every stage of the manufacturing process, from the raw materials to the finishing touches, the pieces of jewellery are inspected to ensure that they meet the most stringent manufacturing criteria.

1. The gold-plated pieces of jewellery are in conformity with the legislation and standards in force to regulate the “gold-plated” appellation (Article 212 A of the General Tax Code, in an Appendix). GL Bijoux makes daily quality control inspections and approved laboratories make periodical inspections of the quality of the gold plating on the jewellery. GL Bijoux always marks all the articles that it manufactures with its maker’s hallmark.
2. The pieces of jewellery are in perfect conformity with the new legislation on the use of nickel (standards IN 1811 and IN 1810 in the Appendix).
3. The silver pieces of jewellery are made from sterling silver (925/000 minimum), and the standard of our silver jewellery is inspected periodically by our laboratory and guaranteed by the official hallmark.
4. Every piece of silver jewellery is hallmarked. GL Bijoux is one of the rare Companies to have received from the Guarantee Departments (Ministry of Finance) the right to use the official hallmarks. GL Bijoux is thereby authorised to stamp the official hallmarks on each manufactured piece of jewellery in strict compliance with the laws in force and under the control of the Guarantee Departments (Decree 2001-1089).
5. Each piece of silver jewellery, according to the aesthetic criteria adopted, is given either a protective coating of rhodium, so it is called rhodium-plated silver jewellery, or a passivation treatment which maintains the colour of the silver while protecting the piece of jewellery from any oxidation.
